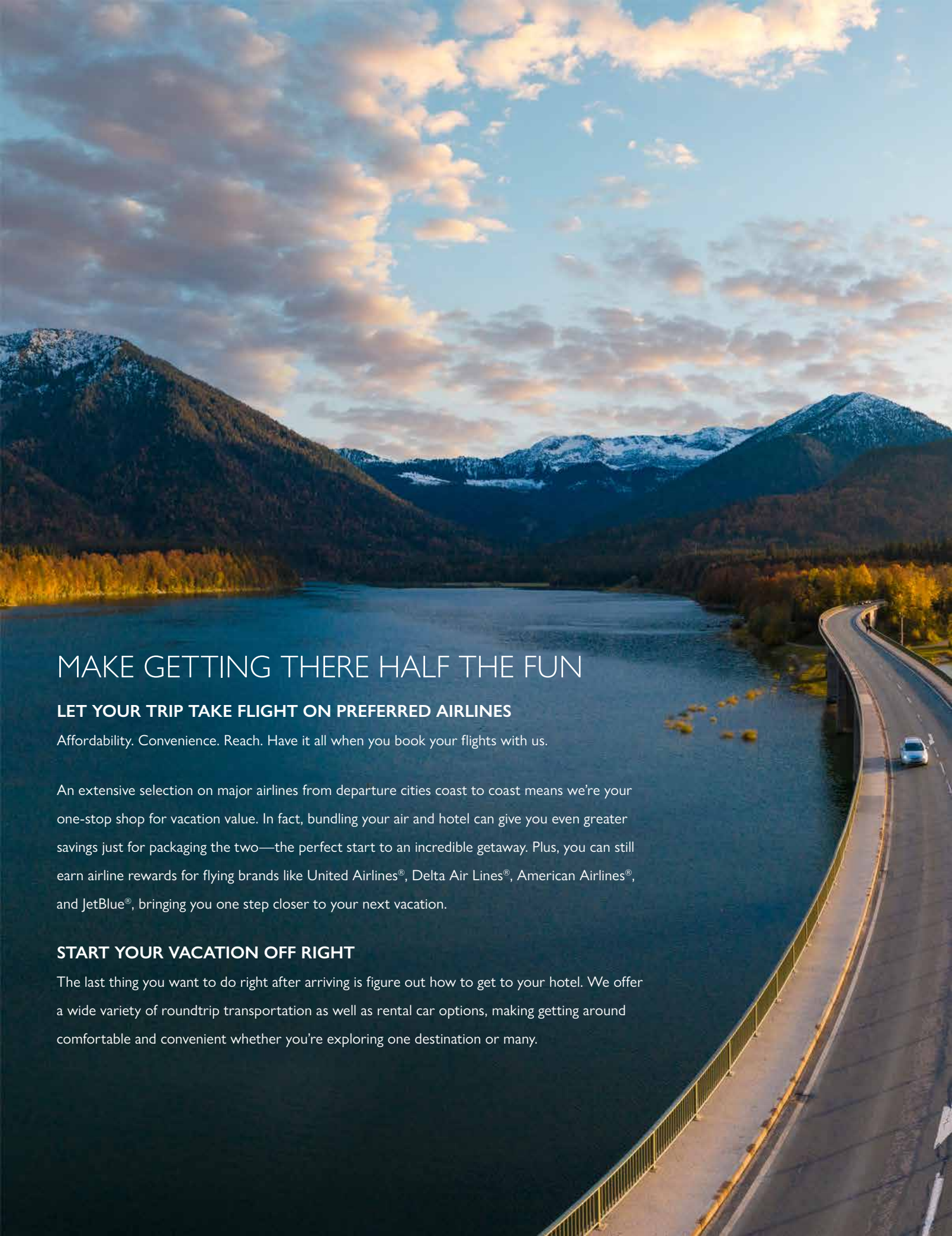

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

To ensure you're fully prepared for your European vacation, please refer to the information below and consult your travel advisor with any questions.

NEW ETIAS REQUIREMENT

In accordance with the European Travel Information and Authorization System (ETIAS), an [ETIAS waiver](#) will be required for U.S. passport holders traveling to the Schengen area of Europe for up to 90 days within a 180-day period. This requirement is expected to become effective in late 2026 (date yet to be announced). Refer to the [ETIAS](#) website for updates.

DOCUMENTATION

Proper documentation is your responsibility. For travel to European countries, your passport must be valid for up to **3 months** after your return. Contact your advisor or the consulates of the countries you're visiting for the most current requirements. We strongly recommend carrying a color copy of your passport's picture page on your person; however, if traveling between countries, carry your actual passport.

HEALTH & SAFETY

We strongly recommend that you visit the [U.S. Department of State](#) and [Center for Disease Control and Prevention](#) websites for important information on foreign travel, as well as our Health & Safety Tips.

BAGGAGE

The standard carry-on size for European carriers is slightly smaller than U.S. domestic flights, measuring 21.7 by 15.7 by 9 inches. Please check your [air carrier's website](#) to ensure that your baggage size and weight meet their requirements.

ELECTRONICS

The official voltage for Europe, the UK, and Ireland is 230, whereas most U.S. outlets are 110V. If your appliances don't use this voltage, you'll need to purchase an outlet converter adaptable for 2 round-pronged or 3 flat rectangle-pronged (UK and Ireland) outlets.

ACCOMMODATIONS AND MEAL PLANS

In general, rooms are smaller than in the Americas, and washcloths and toiletries are often not provided. Many hotels offer meal plans such as:

All-inclusive – Includes all meals, select drinks, daily activities, and nightly entertainment. Such plans may also be referred to as *Endless Privileges®* or *Unlimited-Luxury®*.

Full-board – Includes breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Half-board – Includes breakfast and lunch.

DINING OUT

Tipping in restaurants is appreciated, but often not expected. When tipping is common, 5% is normal and 10% is considered generous. Service is generally less hurried than in the Americas.



USEFUL TIPS

Travel light, wear comfortable shoes, and ensure your luggage has sturdy wheels to withstand the steps and cobble streets of Europe. Also, be prepared to pay a small fee for the use of public restrooms!

WELCOME TO EUROPE

Even with a vast ocean between us, the lure of the Old World is inescapable and its magic untranslatable. Every region in every country has its own deep, wholly unique roots. These roots connect intricately throughout the continent, a complex network from which sprouted the origins of nearly every facet of Western society.

Squint into the distance: you can still see the ghosts of rising dust clouds on roads leading to Rome or Athens. Time travel becomes easy when staying in a historic castle in the wilds of Ireland; among the cypress-guarded hills of sun-drenched Tuscany; or amid the azulejos-tiled buildings of Seville. It simply stands still when sipping an espresso on the canals of Venice or Amsterdam or while listening to the whistle of the wind through the heather of Scotland.

Travel inland and feel the rumble of carriages over age-old cobblestones, reverberating through your soles in places like Frankfurt, Porto, and Paris. Crane your neck until you can stretch it no more to take in majestic spires that twist into the sun in London, Zurich, or Barcelona. Trade those towers for whitewashed buildings capped in blue in Greece or Croatia.

Regardless of the European destination, find yourself swept up in the romance of a fairy tale—a story still being written.









CROATIA

On the Balkan Peninsula is the bridge between the Central European and Mediterranean worlds, a country where fantasylands, medieval magic, and coastal dreaming become real. Skyrocketed into the mainstream media by popular shows and cruises that sail the Dalmatian Coast, these sneak peeks of Croatia are only the beginning. With the Dinaric Alps to the east, Adriatic Sea and Italy to the west, Slovenia and Hungary to the north, and karst plateaus, inland forests, and 1,100 miles of coastline with just as many islands and islets across its narrow span, it's a land dense with sightseeing riches.

Roman, Byzantine, Frankish, and Venetian architectural influence; food infused with Turkish, Italian, and Central European flavors; and a climate that ranges from Mediterranean mildness to warm sirocco winds from Africa add to the experiential diversity of this affordable, independent young country. Then listen for the sound of tamburitza—an instrument similar to a mandolin—from the streets, sip the region's Pag wine, and look for kolo dancing at festivals. From the capital of Zagreb to seafront Split and Dubrovnik, Croatia is the kind of destination that sets imagination alight.

The Pearl of the Adriatic is as recognizable on the small screen as the characters that inhabited its fictional counterpart, but the most arguably picturesque city on the Dalmatian Coast is a star for an infinite number of reasons.

Dubrovnik's name is derived from the word “grove,” but it's now better known for its port fortifications that rise in dramatic fashion from the surf below—a landmark for the UNESCO World Heritage Site that is its Old City. Those double-line walls, erected by the 16th century, tower 80 feet from their base, the numerous towers and fortresses standing guard over historic monuments, villas with pristine gardens, and Renaissance homes on the famous Stradun street. Fourteenth century convents, one of the oldest synagogues in Europe, and a masterpiece of Dalmatian architecture, the Late Gothic Rector's Palace, continue to hold similar sentinel, surviving wars from medieval times to the recent '90s, in dignified constancy for this proud free city of art, literature, and music.

ZAGREB

The capital of Croatia, sheltered in the northwest region of the country, offers a different perspective from the famous coastal towns. Here are the Zagorje Hills, the Julian Alps, and the vines and orchards that now dot several of those rises. There are the Sava and Drava River valleys and their corresponding peaks.

In the Upper Town, the Gothic twin-spired Zagreb Cathedral and 13th century St. Mark's Church rise high in the cityscape, over more modern attractions such as a school of animation so renowned that Zagreb hosts an international film festival annually. Nearby is pedestrian-friendly Tkalčićeva Street, lined with outdoor cafes, but venturing to Lower Town rewards with a main square, Ban Jelačić, plus shops, museums, and parks. Throughout, beautiful 18th to 19th century Austro-Hungarian architecture shines in landmarks such as the National Theatre, National and University Library, and a concert hall named after composer Vatroslav Lisinski.

Together, what was formerly two fortress towns makes for one spectacular vacation destination.

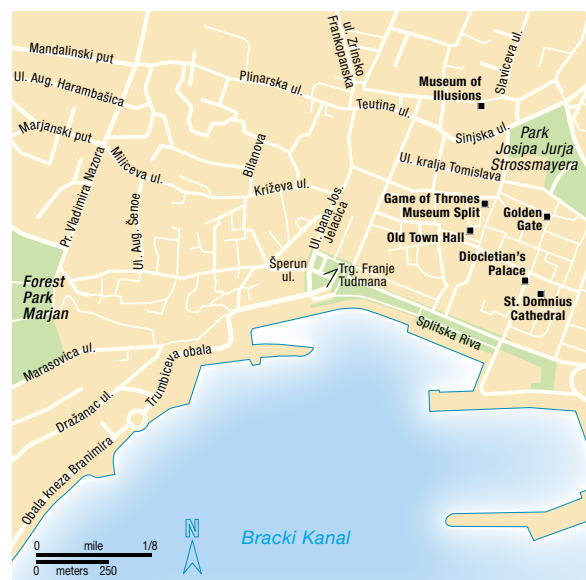


SPLIT

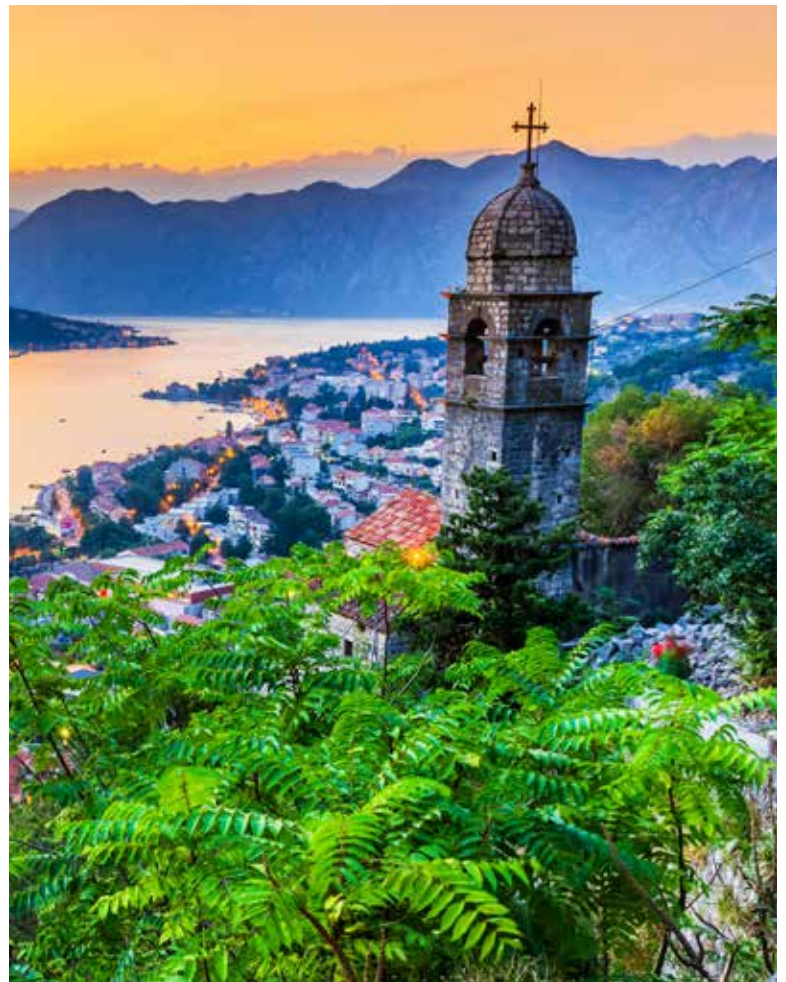




MONTENEGRO
